This program aims to provide graduates with knowledge and skills up to the professional level with some emphasis on logistics and supply chain management.

Entry requirements

Minimum educational requirements may be met by those applicants who have

- completed or partly completed a recognised higher education qualification at a recognised higher education institution.
- successfully completed a recognised diploma or advanced diploma from a Technical and Vocational Education (TVE) institution, in business or a related discipline.

The program is taught in English. Applicants for whom English is a second language must have obtained one of the following standards within the last twelve months:

- International English Language Testing System (IELTS) test - band 6; test - a minimum score of 6.0 in Reading and Writing sub scores and a minimum overall score of 6.0:
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) - a minimum score of 55 (21 in the computer based test) in Reading and Structure/Writing sub scores and a minimum overall score of 550 (213 in the computer based test):
- South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE):
- University Entrance Certificate (CELUSA) - a minimum score of 60% for each of the 10 assessment items including a minimum of 60% being obtained at the first attempt of the 3 test items: or
- Previous successful secondary or tertiary study where English was the first language of instruction.

Content/structure

The program provides a range of materials related to management fundamentals with an emphasis on logistics and supply chain management. The management curriculum covers the areas of human resources, economics, finance, ethics, resource management and project management. The supply chain management curriculum includes a study of logistics engineering, integrated logistics management and supply chain management.
